

Under parental supervision, we encourage the use of cycles and scooters when travelling to nursery and there is storage available on site.

Fee structure and enrollment process

At Purple Willows, our commitment to openness and fairness extends to our fee structure. We strive to make the enrollment process straightforward and offer support to families with various needs. Inclusive Fees

Purple Willows emphasizes transparency by offering fully inclusive fees. This means that there are no hidden extra costs, and the fees cover everything from meals and snacks to nappies, wipes, and creams.

Sibling Discount

Purple Willows offers a 10% discount on fees for the eldest child when two or more siblings are enrolled at the nursery, promoting affordability for families with multiple children attending.

Registration Process

A non-refundable registration fee is required when adding a child's name to the nursery's registry record. Additionally, a holding deposit may be payable, which is fully refundable upon the child's departure from the nursery.

Universal and Extended Entitlements

Purple Willows is aligned with the Government's universal entitlement for early education, providing eligible children with a specified number of funded hours per week. We also facilitate extended entitlements for eligible working families, offering additional hours to support busy parents. Please refer to our funding guide for more information about government funding.

Payment Methods

Fees are payable in advance and can be done through standing order or direct debit, with the expectation that payments reach the nursery's account by the 1st of each month.

Contract Signing

Once offered a place at the nursery, parents are expected to sign a contract. This formalizes the agreement between the parents and the nursery, outlining terms and conditions.
